INTRODUCTION

It is expected that authors will submit carefully written and proofread material. Careful checking for spelling and grammatical errors should be performed.

Prepared papers should clearly describe the background of the subject, the authors work, including the methods used, results and concluding discussion on the importance of the work. Papers are to be prepared in English or Hindi and SI units must be used. Technical terms should be explained unless they may be identified to the general community.

MATERIALS AND METHODS/METHODOLOGY

Provide sufficient detail to allow the work to be reproduced. The uniform appearance will assist the reader to read papers in the journal.

Tables and Figures

Figure captions and table headings should be sufficient to explain the figure or table without needing to refer to the text. Figures and tables not cited in the text should not be presented. The

following is an example for Table 1. Figure and table captions should be in Times New Roman font and 11-point font size.

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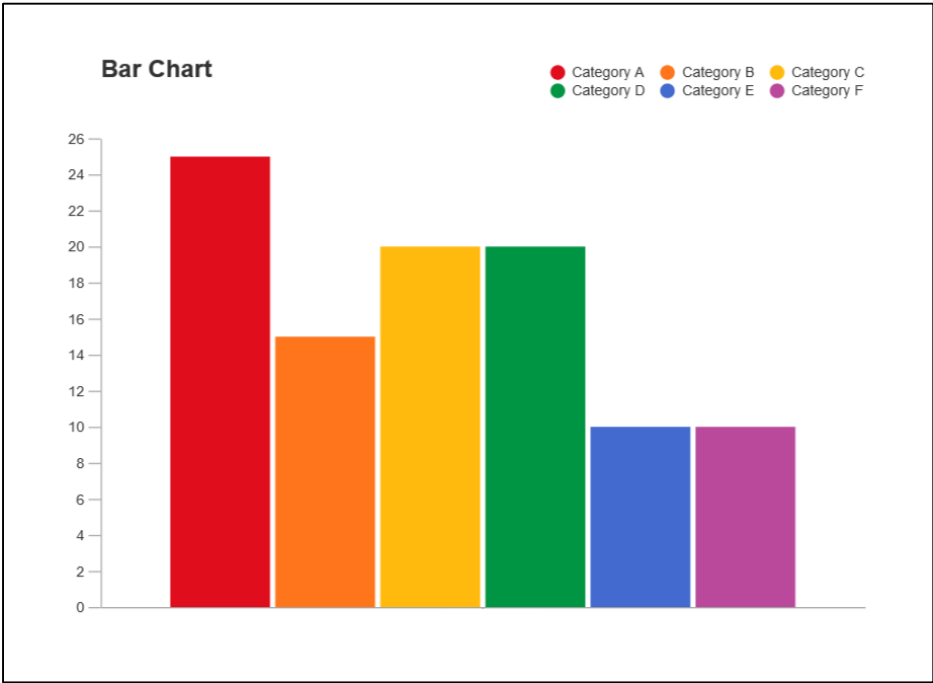


Figure 1. Title of the Figure

Equations

Each equation should be presented on a separate line from the text with a blank space above and below. Equations should be clear, and expressions used should be explained in the text. The equations should be numbered consecutively at the outer right margin, as shown in Eqs. (1) - (2) below. Here is one example.

In this case, the governing system of equations can be written as follows:

RESULTS

Results should be clear and concise.

DISCUSSION

This section should explore the significance of the results of the work, not repeat them.

CONCLUSION

The main conclusions should be summarized here and can also include recommendations or suggest application of the results beyond the study.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS

Sponsorship and financial support acknowledgments should be included here. Acknowledging the contributions of other colleagues who are not included in the authorship of this paper is also added in this section. If no acknowledgement is necessary, this section should not appear in the paper.

REFERENCES

References should be listed in alphabetical order according to the name of the first author.

Manuscript should follow Chicago/APA style of referencing.

NOTE –

All text paragraphs should be single spaced, with first line intended by 0 cm. Position and style of headings and subheadings should follow this example. *1.1 Subheading*

Do not add additional space above or below the lines of text. Do not triple- or quadruple-space between paragraphs.

Fonts

Manuscript should be in Times New Roman font, on A-4 Size paper typed in 1.5 space, with margins (Top & Bottom 2cm: Left & Right 1.5cm).

The number of pages of the paper should be 8 and 10 at least (**as per this template**) OR Manuscript must not be more than 3500 words.

It is therefore suggested to authors to use this template file to construct their paper.
